NEW! Grocery Delivery Program

(Not related to MOW or our Niche Market)

Mobility has been a barrier for many folks in our community when it comes to accessing food. To address the need, Harvest of Hope recently launched a new Grocery Delivery program **specifically to support people who are experiencing long-term or sustained barriers to physically accessing the Pantry.**

Mobility barriers are situations that make it difficult or impossible for an individual to get to the Pantry. Some examples of mobility barriers could be:

- Lack of access to transportation
- Unable to leave the house for some other reason (will need to be shared/identified when signing up for the program)

Inclusion Criteria:

- Reside in the City of Boulder (currently not available in unincorporated areas)
- Verification of a mobility barrier: You will need to identify the barrier and confirm that it will persist for at least one year.
- Ability to access the internet or phone to place your order (or have access to someone to assist with this).
